Morning Seminar - Dangerous Goods and the GHS

This seminar discusses the hazardous chemicals component of NSW's Workplace Health and Safety Regulation 2011. Hazardous Chemicals covering dangerous goods and other hazardous chemicals classified under the Globally Harmonized System will be the focus, especially how the regulatory requirements are changing.

It introduces major changes to the storage and handling of onsite dangerous goods and <u>Global Harmonized System</u> (GHS) chemicals. Under this new regulatory framework NSW is in line with Queensland, ACT, Northern Territory and ComCare. Tasmania will pass their WHS legislation at the start of 2013, and now Victoria has also commenced its process of at adopting the harmonized Hazardous Chemicals classification and labelling requirements.

This Seminar focuses on the new changes in this area is designed to address the requirements of organisations that are involved in the classification, labelling handling, and storage of Hazardous Chemicals.

Afternoon Workshop – Classification and Storage of Hazardous Chemicals

The workshop is based *NSW's new <u>Work Health & Safety Regulation</u>*. It overviews the classification of hazardous chemicals under dangerous goods, the GHS and the ADG code.

This is a practical half-day introductory workshop designed to get supervisors and managers up to speed on NSW's new hazardous chemicals requirements, it considers the <u>Codes of Practice</u> and use of **Australian Standards** on the design of DGs storage depots and labelling.

Facilitator: Andrew Doig, National Director ASBG who is an excellent facilitator and has a broad background with dangerous goods, its storage and handling and management, leads this Workshop.
