- Handling practices to prevent escape and wrong identification
 - Storage 1 → Ensure there is a proper storage area for your hazardous chemicals
 - Storage 2 → How to avoid storing incompatible dangerous goods together
 - Storage 3 → Use of cabinets and common bad storage actions
 - Storage 4 → Basic Dangerous Goods stores and controls
 - Spill control
