This workshop complements our *NSW Contaminated Soils Waste Webinar Part 1*: moving into details on sampling criteria and preparation of Waste Classification Reports, which satisfies the EPA. It also covers the availability of landfills to accept certain contaminated soils with a focus on asbestos waste and where it can be disposed of, noting that future landfill capacity around Sydney will be increasingly constrained over the next 5 years. The workshop is run over two consecutive days [2 x 1 hour sessions] plus question time will cover the following areas. A number of changes to the POEO (General) Regulation which may affect EPL holders will be also included so participants are ready when the changes come in. Key issues addressed include:
